Lakeview requires 60 credit hours in general education and prerequisite courses. It is necessary to fulfill the majority of this coursework at another institution and then transfer credit hours to Lakeview. Additional coursework may be required as some institutions may require prerequisites prior to enrolling in required courses listed. Furthermore, due to varying credit hours for transfer courses, students may be required to complete additional coursework to fulfill the 60 credit hour general education requirements.

Additionally, please be advised that these courses will not qualify for financial aid at Lakeview.

All prerequisite coursework must be indicated on an official transcript from a regionally accredited college or university before students will be able to begin the nursing program.

Additional Requirement: Current CPR Certification. Verification of current certification in CPR is a prerequisite for enrollment in all clinical courses. It must be either Health Care Provider granted through the American Heart Association or CPR-AED for Professional Rescuer granted through the American Red Cross. Ideally this should be taken as close to the Lakeview start date as possible.
